NEXTDOORNEIGHBOR trailed and inside to the lane, raced between rivals late and prevailed under hand urging. DR. HUDSON well placed inside, raced just off the rail turning for home, raced between foes late and finished gamely. COOKIE'S FROM TONY saved ground into the far turn, moved out and raced in the five path into the stretch then finished willingly while needing more. EXCITER dueled for command inside a rival, held a narrow advantage into the lane and yielded through the late stages. ANDRELL vied for the lead outside a rival and weakened late. F D ICY well placed early three wide, raced in the four path entering the stretch and weakened. COOPER'S STORM in good position while just off the inside, raced between rivals turning for home and tired in the drive.
