DR. RAMSEY quickly took command and set a slow pace, was passed but regained command before the eighth fence, drew off after the tenth fence, responded well between challengers at the twelfth fence, gained command on the outside after the thirteenth fence, drew clear near the fourteenth fence, seemed unaffected striking the final fence and increased his lead under steady urging. THE OTHER ME stalked the early pace, dropped back after the seventh fence to trail, rallied on the inside to challenge at the twelfth fence, dueled to near the fourteenth fence, hit the fourteenth fence and couldn't gain thereafter. GATHER NO MOSS raced wide throughout, rallied quickly to gain a short lead after the seventh fence, lost ground on the outside when he was forced to jump the tenth fence when all others ran through the opening left after KILBREENA (IRE) broke through, and weakened after the eleventh fence. PROFESSOR MAXWELL trailed throughout most of the race and had no rally. MEET AT ELEVEN (IRE) raced in the middle of the pack, rallied to challenge for command at the eleventh fence but tired after the twelfth fence. HADDIX was outrun when he shied at the broken fourth fence, stumbled when his rear hooves pushed off a loose board and unseated his rider. KILBREENA (IRE) was forwardly placed on the inside when he struck the fourth fence, stumbled and unseated his rider. EXCENTRIKBYDESIGN struck the first fence, stumbled and unseated his rider.
