ELLIE'S UNREAL set all the pace and drew away to be well clear under all out pressure. BABA'S CHOICE stalked the pace, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished second best. CHANCE OF FLURRIES was unhurried early, raced along the inside and made a mild late gain. TALK AND SING was off very slow, raced five wide and made a mild late gain. SHARON S stalked the pace, raced three wide and had no rally. STICKY GOLD raced five wide in the stretch and never threatened. LARISAANNA was hustled from the inside to press the pace and tired the final quarter of a mile. MSOPPORTUNITY KNOX showed little. DEPUTY'S HOPE failed to menace. SUNDAY JULIET raced seven wide in the stretch and never menaced. MS ROYAL SWAIN failed to menace. KIDLESS was hustled along from the inside and tired.
