DISCREETLY IRISH pressed the pace from the outside while racing three wide, dug in gamely inside the eighth pole and was clear in the final stages under strong encouragement. MISSY CAN DO was quick to begin, set all the pace while racing just off the inside, led in the upper stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner in the final stages. MISSED ACCOUNT stalked the pace from the outside, raced four wide throughout and had no final bid in the drive. DUNHAM'S SOCIAL was allowed to settle early, saved ground and made a mild late gain in the drive. SYN'S BABY RUTHE raced three wide and never was a real threat. KAY COLLEEN showed little. DIAMOND SHEENA failed to menace. DANCIN REGIMENT was outrun. MISS SUGAR BOOGER was hustled along to stalk the leaders and faded. The five eighths mile fraction was unavailable.
