MISSY CAN DO showed good early speed from the outside, built a clear lead around the far turn while racing five deep and held a long lead under constant pressure. TEMPTATIOUS was allowed to settle early, raced three and was no match for the winner. FINE RIDGE stalked the pace, raced just off rail and lacked a final winning bid. WINNING RACES stalked the pace, raced four wide and hung in the lane. MISS CHANCE was hustled along and tired. ENEMY NUMBER TWO pressed the pace along the inside and tired. SWEET NIJINSKY was far back to be distanced. HIS BRIDE was eased up on in the upper stretch.
