PRESISELY TUNED was unhurried while well out from the rail to late in the turn, responded well when asked while angling widest for the drive and closed with a rush to be moving clear at the end. SPEEDY EDNA forced the pace three deep to draw clear midstretch then could not contain the late run of the winner. DINNER BY CANDLITE stalked the pace in good striking position four wide on the turn, finished willingly in the lane but could not get to the top pair. JIMBOS STORMY lacked the needed late rally outside. C L STORMY moved to contention five wide on the turn and offered no late run. LA VIDA MIA disputed the pace between foes to upper stretch and weakened. LIL MISTRESS was angled to the inside before reaching the turn but failed to seriously threaten. AMERICAN BOOTS tired racing outside. IRISH LITTLE GIRL duelled on the pace along the inside to late in the turn and gave way readily. Fractional times were unavailable.
