Footnotes

PAGER stalked the pace, moved up four wide in the stretch and finished gamely to be clear under all out pressure. ARTISTIC MOMENT showed good speed from the inside, dug in nearing the sixteenth pole but couldn't hold off the winner near the wire. CASTLES IN THE SKY pressed the pace, raced three wide and finished willingly to the wire. NICK MISSED was slow early, raced four wide and gained ground gamely in the final stages. BOW RIVER stalked the pace, raced three deep in the lane and weakened a bit the final sixteenth of a mile. PASS THE AMO raced five wide into the upper stretch and never was a serious threat. APACHE GENERAL failed to respond. CRANE AWAY stalked the pace and tired. GLIDININTHECASH failed to menace.
