TIFFANY CASE showed good early, raced just off the inside and held sway in the drive under all out pressure. GRAND STRAND stalked the pace, raced three deep and finished second best. CHARLIES COOK was hustled along to press the pace and weakened a bit in the drive. GIRLS FIRST LOVE was forced to take up sharply at the quarter pole, raced four deep in the drive and finished willingly in the latter stages. CLAIRVOYANT GIPSY raced evenly and had no rally. MISS TWO BAGGER was always back. STUBBORN showed little. DARK BAY was hustled along from the outside and faded. BLUMURR was forced to check nearing the quarter pole. LADY DODGER was hustled along and tired.
