CANYON DE ORO was hustled from the outside, gained command around the first turn, raced just off the rail down the backside and responded gamely in the drive to be clear under an energetic hand ride. RAISE A BOOGER stalked the pace, raced along the inside and finished second best. A BOY NAMED LUKE pressed the pace, raced three wide and weakened. PATCH CONWAY stalked the pace and weakened. CINBUSTER was slow early and never menaced. EXCLUSIVE KID failed to respond. DANCING DOC showed little. KINDA GOTTA WANNA tired badly and was eased up on in the stretch. The mile fractional time was unavailable.
