MONOJET set all the pace, raced along the inside and held gamely in the drive to be clear under strong encouragement. KEPTHECABIN was allowed to settle early, moved up four wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. GET EVEN STEPHEN was unhurried early, moved up five wide in the lane and gained ground in the final stages. DARING DARIA pressed the pace from the outside, raced three wide and weakened the final eighth of a mile. DANCING FANTASY raced evenly and had no rally. DEPUTY'S WHIRL stalked the pace along the inside and tired. DOC HOLLYDAY failed to menace. TOUGH AND BOLD showed little. OUR BIG SQUEEZE failed to menace. ARTA B TRICKY failed to sustain a bid.
