MANOVAN pressed the pace from the outside, raced three wide throughout, gained command through the far turn and held gamely in the lane to be clear under strong encouragement. OUST stalked the pace, raced four wide into the upper stretch and finished second best. INDIAN MOONSHINE was allowed to settle early, raced three wide and gained ground in the final stages. COUNT ON BILL was unhurried early, raced towards the inside and had no late response. LORD KIPLING set all the pace and faded the final eighth of a mile. CANYON DE ORO stalked the pace from the inside and tired. WALTER showed little. ARCTIC TIGER trailed throughout.
