GRYFFINDOR stalked the pace throughout, bid into the stretch, bumped a couple of times with MATTSUTERRUN and proved narrowly best in a hard drive. MATTSUTERRUN raced off to a long early lead, was taken in hand to set a slower pace, responded well to the winner's challenge, bumped lightly a couple of times and just missed in a game effort. HUMDINGER stalked the pace until the real running began and had nothing left. SUNTARA was well placed to the second-last fence and had no rally. CHANGE COURSE was outrun. KING HOSS trailed early, had a mild middle move and tired. UDEMAN trailed for much of the race and couldn't threaten. SILVER WHEAT was well placed early and tired. CUMULUS NIMBUS tired and pulled up before the second-last fence.
