GRINDING SPEED patiently waited at the back of the pack to the second-last fence, unleashed a powerful rally that propel him to the lead after the last fence and prevailed under steady urging. JOHN WYATT trailed through the third fence, steadily advanced to the start of the second circuit, waited patiently while stalking the leaders through the sixteenth fence, rallied strongly before the last fence and edged closer to the winner in the last few strides. EMBARRASSED pressed the pace, gained a short lead early in the second circuit, dueled to the twelfth fence, drew clear and weakened on the hill in the last sixteenth. CALL ME SONNY was unhurried early, trailed through fifth-last fence, rallied mildly into the stretch but failed to sustain his bid. DEALER BEWARE settled in stride in the middle of the pack, steadily advanced to press the pace to the second-last fence, challenged for the lead on the inside to last fence, gave way when he hit it hard and returned lame. MR TACK quickly took command and held a clear lead through the first circuit, dueled for the lead to nearly the thirteenth fence, gave way and was pulled up. GREAT HALO was outrun and pulled up after the thirteenth fence. LEFFINGWELL LION raced in the middle of the pack to the twelfth fence and fell. MONSOONED MALABAR was racing near the back of the field when he lost his jockey.
