WAR MEDAL broke sharply and sprinted to a short lead, dueled inside of CATS CASTLE through the turn, put that one away in the drive and drew clear under intermittent urging. CATS CASTLE was well rated just off the rail, drew even approaching the far turn and dueled outside of the winner, but could not stay with that one in the drive. BID ON stalked the early pace three wide, roused on the turn and made a mild bid but could not stay with the leaders and finished evenly. SQUARE BOB was void of early speed while saving ground and was never a threat. T J'S LUCKY MOON was hustled along close up in the early going, then got tired in the drive and dropped back. LANDLER was void of early speed and never a factor. CALLES D'ORO dwelt at the start and was never a factor. DOMINICAN WALTZ showed little.
