WYNYARD was in hand between horses in the early going, but checked hard on the turn and dropped back, moved to the outside in the drive and got up in the final strides under steady pressure. TACKY AFFAIR was void of early speed just off the rail, swung wide on the turn and started a rally, angled to the inside in the drive and closed willingly getting up for place. ESTRADA chased the early leaders from between horses and was under right handed urging on the turn, continued strong in the drive and finished well. PRINCESS ATTA was void of early speed, roused in the three path on the turn and finished with a late gain. MISTY EXPECTATION was hustled along chasing the early leader from the rail, then weakened in the drive. TEN REBELS broke sharply and set the early pace unchallenged, then stopped in the late going. ELUSIVE ASHLEE stalked the early pace outside of rivals, then dropped back in the stretch. DEBI'S SPORTSCAR was off slowly and never a factor.
