Footnotes

JAB was unhurried early just off the rail, raced three wide between horses on the turn, moved to the rail in the stretch and got up in the final strides. SAMBUCA ON ICE was allowed to settle in the early going, closed the gap five wide on the turn and closed willingly. BEST OF THE DUCK set the early pace in hand, opened a clear lead on the turn, but gave way in the late going. JARRET'S ODYSSEY was hustled along chasing the early leader from between horses, then weakened in the stretch. PASSING SHIPS stalked the early pace three wide and lacked a late response. WHITE ENSIGN was void of early speed in the three path and lacked a late response. UNCLE WOGER stalked the early pace inside of rivals, then dropped back in the stretch. PIONEER BOY was hustled along inside of rivals, then tired in the stretch and dropped back. HIDDEN POCKET was void of early speed and never a factor.
