TORRID AFFAIR stalked the early pace from off the rail, loomed boldly three wide on the turn, drew even in upper stretch and prevailed after a long drive. BARLEE MIST set a pressured pace between horses, battled gamely to the wire but was outfinished. JULIE'S WITT was allowed to settle off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and closed willingly. MYSTERIOUS AFFAIR was hustled along pressing the early pace from the rail, then weakened in the late going. GANDRIA was unhurried early off the rail and never a factor. CAFE DANCER had no early speed inside of rivals, angled out on the turn and finished with a late rally. DANZIGS SILVER raced close up along the rail, then weakened in the stretch. EVERYTHING showed early speed from the outside, then tired. FULLY APPROVED was void of early speed off the rail and never a threat. CLEOCATRA was close briefly then faded.
