SAOIRSE saved ground in the early going, drew even in the turn then drew clear in the drive under intermittent urging. JULIE'S WITT was bumped slightly at the start and void of early speed, rallied between horses in the drive and got up for place. BIG CITY DREAM saved ground in the early going, closed the gap on the leaders in the turn and finished well. EVERYTHING broke sharply and had a short lead in the early going then weakened in the drive. WOOFY pressed the early pace three wide then weakened in the stretch. BARLEE MIST vied for the early lead between horses then weakened. SARAREGAL was void of early speed and never a threat. GREGORIAN CHANCE stalked the early pace well off the rail, stayed four wide through the turn and failed to respond when asked then dropped back in the drive.
