### Footnotes

MISS INDEPENDENCE sprinted to the early lead from the outside, assumed a clear lead in the turn and moved to the rail, stayed clear in the drive and was much the best. COPELAN'S VANITY chased MISS INDEPENDENCE from the rail, battled gamely in the drive but was no match for that one. MORNING STAR was allowed to settle between horses but lacked a late rally. REGAL CROWN was hustled along between horses and lacked a late rally. BOLD TO LOVE was hustled along well off the rail, went four wide in the turn and ran evenly. VIXEN STAR broke a step slow but was rushed to contention along the rail, saved ground throughout but was never a factor. DOLLY'S DREAM GIRL was void of early speed then passed tiring rivals. ALPINE ASTER showed no speed. MIRBECK was hustled along between horses then tired in the drive and dropped back.
