DRINKWITHTHEDEVIL led quickly, sprinted clear early turn then widened in the stretch under an aggressive hand ride. HALF SISTER, well back early, closed three-wide late turn and finished determinedly. MOST TREASURED stalked four-wide, was all out in the stretch. DIXIETWOSTEPPER forced the pace from between foes, flattened out in the final furlong. BELLA RUSH raced midpack between horses, hung in the stretch. LAVENDER BAG, well back early, raced on the second path, was roused but did not threaten. YOU FIRE ME UP dueled early on the rail, chased through the turn, was roused upper stretch, but tired. INQUISITIVE DANCER raced off the pace along the rail, lacked a rally. COMES UP HEADS was hustled along five wide and tired in the stretch.
