Footnotes

BWANA Z, in range between horses, angled from the second path to four-wide on the turn, rallied outside and bid midstretch then prevailed under a drive. LOGANS REGAL CHARM had early speed between rivals, gained a short lead on the turn, held her advantage into the stretch then failed to stave off the winner in the final sixteenth. DAME CLIEQUOT had speed along the rail, dropped back at the turn but continued to chase, launched an all out charge upper stretch but evened out in the late stages. WEEKENDONTHEBEACH showed early speed then forced the issue on the turn, raced gamely to the final furlong and tired. ADRINKWITHFRIENDS, still in range at the rear of the pack, angled out four-wide late turn but evened out in the stretch. THIRD TIME LUCKY, in range early from the outside, was hustled five-wide late turn then lacked a stretch response.
