MYMISSJULIAC led quickly, set a reserved pace, was hustled into the stretch and kept to business for the win. INDYCAT stalked the pace, chased five-wide late turn and finished best of the rest. ITS FUN TO RUN stalked along the rail, chased late turn and finished all out. TIME SHARING raced off the pace, was roused three-wide late turn and finished gamely in vain. EXECUTIVELY, up close early, chased four-wide late turn and was all out through the stretch. CELEBRIAN, prominent early, forced the pace but was taken back at the turn, was hustled into the stretch but lacked a strong closing response. DANCING CHARM settled off the pace, angled from two to four-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch but was never a threat.
