MOON RUCKUS kept in touch then bid 3-wide on the stretch turn, rallied outside of foes and cleared in the late going. SUNDAY PRINCE stalked the leaders and kept close, bid between foes in the drive and finished off a solid effort. SABABA off the early pace then in the 3-path and gaining turning for home, closed ground late while outside of foes. GILFORD tracked the leader then bid outside that one on the turn, took command briefly but weakened inside of foes in the final furlong. CUSACK was off slowly, trailed in the early going and on the turn then failed to threaten while in the 5-path into the stretch. HARD ICE had speed to lead into the turn, was pressured from the outside, gave way in the drive and faded. DANZIGS TRICK saved ground while in touch in the early going, then tired in the stretch run. BLACK RAPID in mid field, failed to rally and was not a threat at any time.
