SILVER PIZZAZZ settled off the pace, trailed in the early going, was wide into the stretch then rallied strong from there and arrived in time. KID SPARKLE had speed to lead the way into the turn, drifted out slightly on the turn the failed to last to the wire. THIRD TIME LUCKY off the early pace and saving ground, came on in the drive and had a late try between foes. MIDNIGHT JOKER settled in the early going, saved ground, bid in the drive and finished willingly from the rail. BRIDGE TO GOLD on the outside of foes and three wide on the turn, put in a mild stretch try from there. JUMPTOCONCLUSIONS hustled into contention from the outside, was in striking distance and off the rail on the turn the weakened outside foes in the drive. CHEMISTRY FLASH bobbed at the break, rushed between foes and forced the early pace, was a factor on the turn then faltered. SINISTER RUCKUS chased the leaders from between foes on the turn then tired.
