TRUE VINDICATION settled off the pace and in the four path on the turn, rallied in the 5-path through the stretch and ran down the leader to prevail. BOLD NURSE had inside speed, vied with rival on the turn, cleared and led into deep stretch then was caught late. LAKE SECRET off the early pace, was in the five path into the stretch then rallied outside and was up for the show. YUMMY WITH BUTTER veered out at the break, trailed then had a late run in the drive. PASO DOBLE was bumped at the break, kept in striking distance and had an even effort. BRIGHT PICK tracked the leaders while inside then lacked the needed rally. LONE ENDEAVOR was steadied into the turn while in mid pack, backed off and had no recovery run. DOUBLE COLICO up close and settled outside and just back of the leaders, faltered in the drive. MAIN EXECUTIVE dueled outside of rival into the turn, was not able to match turning for home then faded.
