RIDING THE RIVER, close early, chased on the turn, responded smartly upper stretch and swept to the lead just into the final furlong and widened under a strong hand ride. MOLINARO GIOELLO dueled from the rail, gained a short lead on the turn, was passed in the final furlong but held the place. SET IN STONE vied on the backstretch, forced the issue on the turn then finished gamely in vain. MISTER PINK, in range early, chased three-wide on the turn but failed to menace. GOLD XCHANGE raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn but never reached contention. VICTORY LAUNCH, in touch early, was hustled through the turn then evened out in the stretch. LARGEDOUBLEDOUBLE taken in hand early, was hustled on the turn but was never a factor. ONE COOL MIL was used early to gain position then dropped back nearing the turn, was hustled along but lacked a rally.
