### Footnotes

PLAYING GAMES moved to the front in the backstretch under a tight hold, opened a clear lead on the turn and entered the stretch five lengths in front, responded to left handed urging in the drive and widened the margin in the final furlong. REDCARPETTREATMENT was void of early speed along the rail in the early going, swung wide entering the stretch and rallied belatedly getting up for place. READY I AM was hustled along four wide chasing the early lead, then weakened in the drive. DIVINE ROCKETTE was void of early speed while off the rail then finished with a mild bid. PRINCESS JADE assumed command exiting the chute, but gave way to the winner in the backstretch and dropped back. PETIONETTE was in hand between horses, roused on the turn and made a mild bid, but tired in the drive and dropped back. ILKLEY MOOR BAHTAT was allowed to settle inside of rivals, then dropped back on the turn.
