Footnotes

EXPECT A MINT dueled for the early lead outside of CRIMSON COURTIER, shook loose on the turn, drew clear entering the stretch and held the margin under steady pressure. CAVALIER BILLIE stalked the early pace from between horses, closed the gap between horses on the turn, but was blocked and steadied for a few strides, got up for place entering the stretch and held that position under steady pressure. HARTS GAP was allowed to settle outside of rivals, closed the gap on the turn four wide, but flattened out in the drive. KENDI LOU was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn and closed willingly in the drive. REALLY KEEN was allowed to settle three wide, came between horses on the turn and was full of run, moved to the outside in the drive, but flattened out and was never a threat. BARBELLA stalked the early pace three wide, but failed to respond. CRIMSON COURTIER was away alertly and showed brief speed, then got tired on the turn and was steadied while dropping back. PIVOTAL PROSPECT was void of early speed and never a factor. SECRET RUSH pressed the early pace three wide, then dropped back on the turn. LOST MY KNICKERS showed little and was never a factor.
