TURNER'S HALL broke sharply and set the early pace in hand, opened a clear lead on the turn and widened the margin in the drive, then held off a late charging MARISA GO under steady pressure. The latter was void of early speed just off the rail, roused four wide on the turn and rallied belatedly. MISS SWEEP pressed the early pace four wide, then weakened in the stretch. SCREEN HAPPY was allowed to settle between horses, made a mild bid on the turn, but flattened out in the drive. CRUMPET was close up three wide and lacked a late response. VIXEN STAR was void of early speed and never rallied. SWAMP QUEEN was hustled along pressing the early pace between horses, then dropped back on the turn. REGALCLASS was void of early speed along the rail and outrun. DEMALOOTPHOTOSHOOT was hustled along pressing the early pace inside of rivals, then faded on the turn.
