TELL HER, up close early, bid along the rail and led into the turn, set a pressured pace, shook clear approaching the stretch then was all out to hold. SAMANTHA ROYALE chased up close, saved ground then finished determinedly and held place. VALOREM chased in touch, was hustled three-wide on the turn then evened out in deep stretch. SUGAR GLIDER, close early, was steadied near the turn then dropped back early turn, was blocked along the rail midstretch but was game once clear. LIVADA showed speed, was headed nearing the turn, forced the issue to the stretch and tired a 16th out. LADY ZSA ZSA raced in midpack between foes, was hustled two and three-wide on the turn then evened out in the stretch. GUPPY SMUGGLER raced midpack in touch with the leader, was hustled four-wide into the stretch but evened out. OFFLEE BOSSY settled off the pace, was hustled four and five-wide on the turn then lacked a closing response.
