Footnotes

OLIVIA'S SONG bobbled at the start, gained command briefly then settled, closed late turn, bid along the rail upper stretch and drove clear then held under steady pressure. BUBBLES TO THE TOP pressed the pace, bid midturn, gained command then was collared upper stretch but still finished determinedly. HIGHLANDDIXIEBELLE set a pressured pace, was headed midturn, chased into the stretch then evened out. TIME CAPSULE dropped back early, chased late turn and finished gamely in vain. FORUM'S BEST pressed the pace, chased four and five-wide on the turn then flattened out in the late stages. BURMAH STAR raced in midpack, was roused seven-wide late turn but was never a threat. CANADIAN LADY broke outward and was checked, closed between foes on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch but evened out. ANNA MAY CAPRI broke inward, raced off the pace, chased late turn, was all out upper stretch but flattened out. BAR IS OPEN forced the pace to midturn, gave way a little, chased to the stretch and tired.
