PANTASTIC raced off the pace, chased on the turn, came four-wide into the stretch, bid just into the final furlong, wore down the leader and drew clear late, driving. PLAN FOR GOLD raced off the pace, was hustled three-wide on the turn, cut to the rail nearing the stretch, rallied gamely then evened out in the late stages. NO PEACE AT ALL, in touch early, bid into the turn, dueled and gained command upper stretch, was engaged in the final furlong and failed to hold with a sixteenth to run. ALPINE THUNDER settled off the early pace, was hustled while angling from the rail to four-wide on the turn then finished gamely to no avail. FIRST RATE broke awkwardly, raced in the middle of the pack, angled from two-wide to five-wide through the turn, was under a drive then evened out in deep stretch. REGIONAL EXPERTISE led quickly, was engaged near the turn, dueled to upper stretch and tired.
