Footnotes

KAFIRISTAN pulled to a short lead on the main track, was joined in a duel, vied through the turn, drove clear upper stretch and widened under pressure. BISSIX HILL sprinted to an early lead in hand, was headed but quickly rebid, dueled on the turn, yielded upper stretch then chased to the end although in vain. OBAN raced off the pace, was hustled late turn and rallied mildly through the stretch. PUT IT ON HOLD, in touch, was hustled two to four-wide through the turn but failed to menace. CAVAICHI stalked the pace, chased on the turn and finished all out. SERIOUS INDEED raced off the pace, came three and four-wide through the turn, was hustled into the stretch but never threatened. RUNAWAY CONTENDER raced off the pace, was hustled through the turn then flattened out in the stretch. PLACENTIA BAY stalked the pace, gave way steadily through the turn and was through.
