FIRE CHIEF led midway of the backstretch, set the pace then held sway under intermittent urging. CHILKOOT PASS showed brief speed, was headed midway of the backstretch then forced the pace, ducked out a bit upper stretch then finished determinedly. SOUTHBOUND AGAIN raced midpack, closed into the turn, stalked the pace to the stretch then finished gamely. GULCH KNIGHT, in range, chased on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch, launched an all out drive but evened out in deep stretch. BULLONTHEWIRE settled off the pace, was hustled along the rail then two-wide on the turn and rallied belatedly in the stretch. YOU'RE FUNNY raced off the pace, was hustled three and four-wide through the turn then evened out in the late stages. BABY BEAR broke alertly then gradually settled off the pace, raced on the second path through the turn but lacked a rally.
