KINGS PARADE outside foes in the early going, bid between on the turn and into the stretch, took command then was full out to stave off outside foe late. J J FOR DAVE off the early pace then five wide while gaining into the stretch, kept coming but missed in a good try. MOBIL UNIT had speed outside of foe, vied into the stretch then gave way. JET SET EXEC was in touch then between foes on the turn only to lack a finish. RIMAL AL SAHARA in the hunt, angled out for a stretch try but lacked the needed kick. BRALORNE stalked from the inside then lacked a stretch bid. SEPTEMBER SQUARE dueled with outside foe and battled on the turn then faltered inside of rivals.
