NATURAL MYSTIC bid two deep into the turn, gained a short lead at the top of the stretch and held FUNNY PECULIAR safe under a drive. MISS JUICEY forced the duel while four-wide, ran at the leader in the stretch but hung. JOVIAL JILL forced the pace along the rail, moved to the second path and dropped back a bit then finished gamely in vain. CRITICAL PATH, well back three-wide, was roused five-wide at the top of the stretch and finished all out. LA GRAN EMMA raced off the pace, saved ground and never threatened. EL LACE bid three-wide into the turn, vied to upper stretch and tired. SPANISH COLONY raced off the pace between rivals, lacked a rally. HIGHLAND FLARE raced off the pace three-wide, moved four-wide late turn then lacked a rally. SNEAKY DEE showed speed between horses, duelled from the rail early turn, gave way late turn and tired.
