GONE TRAJECTORY, well back early while off the rail, angled out further on the turn then rallied five-wide and swept by in the late stages under a drive. HUBBERT'S PEAK raced off the pace, came three-wide through the turn and finished determinedly. CIANO NIGHTS, off the pace while saving ground, moved off the rail leaving the turn and finished all out between horses. ROCKGLEN was used early to gain command, was quickly,joined in a duel, edged ahead on the turn and drew off but tired in the final sixteenth. ME THE SEA AND G T, in range early, chased from the rail on the turn then evened out in the stretch. PAYNES GOLD raced off the pace, was hard ridden on the turn while three-wide and finished gamely in vain. KINSHASA'S PARADIS, in range early, was hustled two-wide through the turn then had no stretch response. INSIDE EXECUTIVE moved up quickly to duel along the rail, gave way late turn and tired in the stretch.
