**Footnotes**

SWEEPING ODESSA was off a step slow then rushed to contention and drew even entering the far turn, dueled outside of GIAS BEST to upper stretch, put that one away in the final furlong and drew clear under steady pressure. MI ANGELICA was void of early speed while off the rail, swung wide on the turn and started a rally, moved back to the two path in the drive and finished well getting up for place. GIAS BEST dueled for the early lead inside of the winner while off the rail, then tired in the stretch. ROSANA'S INTENTION was void of early speed along the rail and never a factor. DANCING BROOKE was close up just off the rail, lugged out on the turn and was steadied behind MAKE MAGIC in the drive and dropped back. The latter chased the early leaders from the three path, then broke down in mid stretch and was pulled up.
