RANDY REGENT was void of early speed well off the rail, stayed wide through the turn, came four wide in upper stretch and was full of run getting up in the final strides. ONE WAY LOVE was allowed to settle three wide, came between horses in upper stretch and started a rally, went inside of the leaders in the last sixteenth and closed fast but was outfinished. BURGER DAY was hustled along dueling for the early lead with TRANSFERRED, put that one away in the turn and dueled again with UNCLE WOGER, put that one away in the last furlong but was outfinished in a good effort by the first and second place finishers. UNCLE WOGER stalked the early pace along the rail, drew even in the turn and dueled with BURGER DAY but could not sustain the bid and weakened in the final strides. SHARCAN stalked the early pace between horses and ran evenly. DEPUTY INXS broke alertly and stalked the early pace four wide, was never far back but lacked a late rally and ran evenly. ARTIC SQUIRE was off a step slow and never a threat. TRANSFERRED was hustled along dueling for the early lead off the rail then tired in the drive. ICE WATER was allowed to settle along the rail then dropped back in the drive in a dull effort.
