FAR AND NEAR was away alertly and well rated just off the early lead, drew even on the turn and dueled outside of TOURING STAR, then responded well in the drive and drew clear under steady pressure. BAISER D'AMOUR was unhurried early in the middle of the pack, roused four wide on the turn and finished well. SILVER NITHI was unhurried early outside of rivals and continued widest on the turn, came four wide in the drive and closed willingly. PHONE CHANGE was slow early three wide, then found her best stride in the late going. TOURING STAR set the early pace in hand, dueled inside of the winner entering the stretch, but weakened in the drive and dropped back. JUDGE ME IFYOUCAN was unhurried early just off the rail, then checked at the three eighths pole, angled to the outside in the drive and rallied belatedly. LASS'S SWORD stalked the early pace three wide, but failed to respond and dropped back in the drive. FLASHY THUNDER was void of early speed off the rail, then dropped back on the turn and was never a threat. AMERICAN TRADITION was unhurried early between horses and lacked a late response. A LOOSE KISSER raced close up inside of rivals, then dropped back in the stretch. YVONNE GOES ON pressed the early pace between horses and was under left handed urging on the turn, then faded in the drive. FIDDLERS MOON was void of early speed inside of rivals and never rallied. SLY BUTTERFLY raced close up between horses, then dropped back in the stretch.
