CANT CATCH WYNSTON emerged with a clear lead on the main track, set a reserved pace then was all out to hold. SPEYSIDE broke in the air, was rated in midpack, closed on the turn then finished determinedly and just missed. CURLING ROCKS settled in midpack, chased four and five-wide on the turn then rallied gamely. BEAR'S LAUNCH broke outward, saved ground on the turn, chased into the stretch, lost his path along the rail midstretch, came off the rail but evened out. NICE SHOT raced in midpack in hand, was set down upper stretch and finished willingly, but late. PROFIT PREFERRED, in touch, chased on the turn, was roused four-wide late turn then evened out midstretch. MOLINARO JEWEL, rated off the pace, came three to five-wide through the turn, chased into the stretch and finished with a mild rally outside. HE'S ETAIN, in touch, chased five-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. WESSIE THE CAT settled off the pace, came four-wide through the turn but never threatened. CASH FOR LIFE stalked the pace to late turn and tired. REMEMBER TO DREAM stalked the pace, tired midturn and faded.
