SUAVE VOIR FAIRE settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn, rallied three-wide and got up in the final strides, driving. LATIN LASHES led onto the main track, set a reserved pace, was all out through the stretch but failed to hold the winner safe. ADMITIT stalked the pace, chased two-wide late turn then evened out in the stretch. STAGE TRIP broke slowly, raced off the pace, closed late turn then rallied belatedly. CHURCH VIEW stalked the pace, saved ground, was roused at the top of the stretch but lacked a serious response. GALLOPING D'AMOUR raced in midpack, chased three-wide on the turn but never reached contention. HOI AN, off alertly, stalked the pace, chased hard late turn then flattened out in the stretch. NICOLA'S NICKERS settled off the pace, was hustled on the turn then lacked a closing response.
