FOXY DEVIL had speed, dueled, shook clear midturn then held sway under a hand ride. BILL'S THRILL, hustled early, pressed the duelers, chased hard late turn and finished all out. HIGHER HEIGHTS was hustled early, chased hard from midpack on the turn but was never a serious threat. GIVEYOURHEADASHAKE raced off the pace, angled from three to eight-wide through the turn, was roused late turn and showed a mild rally but failed to menace. STAY CLEAR settled off the pace, angled two to six-wide through the turn, was all out in the stretch but was not a threat. AYENDA raced off the pace, angled from two to six-wide through the turn then lacked a strong closing response. MISS BEST raced well back, angled from the rail to six-wide late turn, was steadied behind a rival upper stretch and did not threaten. SASSYMAY broke poorly, closed and bid late backstretch, dueled briefly then chased to the stretch and tired.
