### Footnotes

SOUR GRAPES, led briefly midway of the backstretch, forced the pace outside two others on the turn, bid at the top of the stretch and drove clear. EUPHRASIA showed speed, was taken back to stalk the pace on the backstretch, chased into the stretch and finished all out. IS IT COOL had brief speed, settled in range, chased three and four-wide on the turn then finished gamely in vain. SUNSHINE PROMISE dueled into the turn, gained a short lead, was engaged at the top of the stretch, yielded quickly but chased to the end. NIKKIS BOLD GELATO, off a step slowly, was hustled along in range then failed to menace. MISS SCARLETT ROAD dueled into the turn, forced the pace from between rivals but tired at the top of the stretch. BLONDIE THE BEST, in touch early, chased from the rear of the pack on the turn then lacked a stretch response.
