A supplemental nomination may be made no later than the time of final entry by a non-refundable fee of \$2,500.00 which includes the entry fee. Footnotes

ABOUNDING TRUTH raced midpack, closed between horses late turn, launched a strong drive in the stretch and just got up. HIGH BUTTON SHOES showed speed, dueled three-deep, gained a short lead in the stretch, was all out but just failed to stave off the winner. LISTEN broke alertly, dropped back but stayed in range, closed leaving the turn and bid between horses at the top of the stretch, chased HIGH BUTTON SHOES then weakened late. CULPEPER MOON, off a step slowly, remained patient until late turn then rallied smartly between foes. COLONIAL SURPRISE raced midpack, came three-wide through the turn, responded to strong rousing at the top of the stretch and finished gamely. MISS CONCERTO, well back early, launched her rally four-wide late turn and gained belatedly. CELTIC WAY raced midpack between horses, was all out in the stretch but needed more. WHISPERTOASCREAM raced midpack, saved ground, launched a mild run upper stretch then hung in the final sixteenth. BOSSKIRI, prominent from the outset, dueled along the rail on the turn, weakened in the stretch. SEARCH THE CHURCH had rail speed, vied on the backstretch but gave way entering the turn, chased to the stretch and tired. KABUL trailed the field, moved off the rail midturn but never threatened. RUNAWAY SUNSHINE dueled between horses, tired at the top of the stretch then faded quickly. FRIENDLY THERESA dueled four-wide to late turn and tired.
