FIRE CHIEF led quickly then was joined in a duel, edged ahead midturn, moved clear then held sway under a hand ride. OMEGA MINISTER raced off the pace, came four-wide through the turn, swung out at the top of the stretch and rallied willingly. LONE ENDEAVOR, in touch, was hustled along angling from the rail to three-wide through the turn, chased, but evened out in deep stretch. PAYNES GOLD raced midpack, dropped back on the turn, responded in the stretch then rallied between foes. BONNIE'S VIEW raced off the pace, closed into the turn, came four-wide to the top of the stretch but finished evenly. SUNDAY PRINCE moved up quickly to duel, yielded grudgingly midturn, chased into the stretch and tired. YOU DON'T PASS stalked the pace four and five-wide, chased hard late turn then evened out in the stretch. EXPECT COLONIAL raced off the pace, moved over to the rail late turn but never reached contention. INDY JOE stalked three and four-wide, chased into the stretch and tired. IT'S TIME BEAR raced midpack from the outside, backed away five and six-wide late turn and had no late response.
