DEPUTY INXS pressed the pace between horses, failed to respond around the turn in the three path, dropped back in upper stretch and altered course, came outside of the leaders in the last furlong and closed with a rush. STEPHANOTIS stalked the early pace outside of rivals, assumed command in upper stretch, but was unable to hold off the winner. MY IMPERIAL SLEW was rushed to the lead along the rail, set a pressured pace just off the rail, drifted slightly in the drive and weakened. RIGHT REVVED stalked the early pace between horses, but lacked a late response. BARTHOLOMEW BANDY was unhurried early outside of rivals, made a mild bid around the turn from the four path, but flattened out in the drive. SILVER TALK was allowed to settle in the early going, saved ground around the turn, then tired in the stretch.
