KIELBASA had early speed, set the pace then drew off under a drive through the stretch. BALTIC VERSE showed brief speed then settled, stalked three-wide and finished determinedly. CARMA MOON stalked from the inside, angled out in the stretch and finished all out. CAT N SASSY raced off the pace, was hustled three then four-wide on the turn, came five-wide into the stretch and finished gamely. HANDSOME NED raced off the pace, was hustled on the turn and angled from the rail to three-wide then evened out in the stretch. DICK WHITTINGTON pressed the pace, chased the leader into the stretch then flattened out. SEVENTEEN RED, in touch three-wide, came four-wide into the stretch then tired in the final furlong.
