COBBLERS ROCK vied for the early lead three wide, opened a length lead on the turn, continued strong in the drive and widened the margin under intermittent urging. THREE SEVENS was hustled along pressing the early pace from the inside, could not stay with the winner in the drive, but finished gamely and was a clear second. DEVIL'S PROPHET stalked the early pace from the outside, closed the gap four wide on the turn, but flattened out in the final furlong. SLEWHOME pressed the early pace from between horses, then weakened in the stretch. AND I was off slowly and trailed early, moved to the outside and closed the gap, but was never a threat. UNCLE WOGGER was unhurried early between horses and lacked a late response. RUSHISCOMINGUP was void of early speed off the rail and outrun. ANYBODY HOME was close up inside of rivals, then dropped back in the stretch.
