WANDO stalked the duel four wide, advanced on the turn, had to wait on the late turn, gained a clear path in upper stretch rallying four wide, and wore down I'M THE TIGER to get by late. I'M THE TIGER stalked the duel five wide outside of the winner, advanced on the turn, and had the winner hemmed in late on the turn, gained command in upper stretch, gave way late while giving his best. EL RULLER raced inside, advanced off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, finished with a late rally. ABA DABA DOO trailed while three wide, made a mild rally in the stretch. MAZENGAH pressed the pace from between horses, came under left handed urging on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. SOITENLY had a short lead early, duelled three wide, had a brief lead on the turn, gave way in upper stretch. BIDDY'S LAD hustled inside to duel, gave way on the turn, and faded.
